## Implementation risk starts before launch

Consultation-led rollout is how intelligent infrastructure becomes stable, measurable and commercially useful.

## Quick checklist

- Set a shared rollout objective across stakeholders.
- Define ownership for approvals, exceptions and reporting.
- Build adoption checkpoints into rollout planning.
- Create a live review cadence for post-launch performance.
